The Human Rights Commission of Sri Lanka commemorates International Human Rights Day 2022 to mark the 74th Anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR). The theme for this year is "*I Have a Voice – Dignity, Freedom & Justice for all*".

The focus of International Human Rights Day of this year will be on vulnerable people in society, such as children, women, persons with disability, elders, the LGBTIQ community, urban poor, etc., and give them the platform to raise their voices. Government authorities and civil society members will be participating in this dialogue.

The keynote speech will be delivered by Hon. Justice Asoka De Silva Chief Justice (Retired) of the Supreme Court of Sri Lanka.
