

The HRCSL Commemorated the International Human Rights Day - 2022

On the 12th of December 2022, the Human Rights Commission of Sri Lanka (HRCSL) commemorated International Human Rights Day 2022 at Lakshman Kadiragamar Institute under the theme of “I have a Voice – Dignity, Freedom and Justice for all”. The event focused on challenges faced by vulnerable or marginalized groups within the Human rights context. Approximately 120 participants from government institutions and civil societies participated in this event. Honourable Chief Justice (Retired) of the Supreme Court of Sri Lanka Asoka De Silva was invited as the Chief Guest of this Occasion. A speech was delivered by Justice Rohini Marasinghe, Chairperson of the HRCSL and then the keynote speech was delivered by the Honorable Chief Justice (Retired) of the Supreme Court of Sri Lanka Asoka De Silva.



Furthermore, there was a dialogue between groups of people belonging to marginalize or vulnerable communities such as Persons with disabilities, Muslim Displaced women, Dwarf, Free Trade Zone Workers, LGBTQ community, war affected women headed families, sex workers, rural women, indigenous community, Victim of Torture, Gypseis, Media, Youths and women from the plantation sector.
